

## **Inclement Weather**

In the event that the decision is made to cancel worship services due to inclement weather, Trinity will use the following methods to notify the congregation of such cancellations:

1. An email notification will be sent to all who are subscribers to our email list for “special announcements”. If you are not subscribed to this list, you may do so by going to [www.tlcleavenworth.org](http://www.tlcleavenworth.org) and clicking on “Sign Up for E-Mail Lists” and following the instructions.
  
2. Trinity will notify the following television stations of closure:
  - a. KSHB
  - b. KMBC
  - c. KCWE

Please watch for the closure notifications on these stations or check their websites.

3. Notification will be posted on Trinity’s website: [www.tlcleavenworth.org](http://www.tlcleavenworth.org)

If weather forecasts do not merit cancellation of services, but call for weather that will likely drastically reduce attendance, Trinity will hold the regular Saturday evening service (unless cancellation is otherwise communicated) and only one Sunday worship service at 10:45 am. Holy Communion will be served at this service. If this option is chosen, Trinity will use the following methods to notify the congregation:

1. An email notification will be sent to all who are subscribers to our email list for “special announcements”. If you are not subscribed to this list, you may do so by going to [www.tlcleavenworth.org](http://www.tlcleavenworth.org) and clicking on “Sign Up for E-Mail Lists” and following the instructions.
  
2. Trinity will notify the following television stations of late or delayed opening:
  - a. KSHB
  - b. KMBC
  - c. KCWE

Please watch for the closure notifications on these stations or check their websites and know that a report of late or delayed opening means that Trinity has only one Sunday service at 10:45 am.
