

We are unable to have a personal relationship with God because we are sinners.

(Romans 5:12)

- ◆ Our sinful condition prevents us from entering a personal relationship with God. (Romans 5:6)
- ◆ Because of our sinful condition we are spiritually dead. (Ephesians 2:1-2)

God is our heavenly Father.
(John 6:27)

- ◆ God is holy, therefore by His own nature can not tolerate sin. (Leviticus 11:45)
- ◆ God is just, therefore He must punish sin. (Deuteronomy 32:4)
- ◆ God is love, therefore God provided a way to start a personal relationship with Himself for us. (I John 4:8)

God the Father sent His only son, Jesus Christ, to earth on our behalf. (Isaiah 42:6, John 3:16)

- ◆ Jesus is both man and God. (Romans 9:5)
- ◆ Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead for the forgiveness of sins for all people. (Romans 4:25)
- ◆ Jesus ascended into heaven to rule with all authority over heaven and earth. (Matthew 28:18)

God the Holy Spirit brings us into faith in Christ through the Gospel or baptism. (Titus 3:4-7)

- ◆ The Spirit convicts us of our sinfulness (John 16:8)
- ◆ The Spirit grants us faith in Jesus Christ. (I Cor. 12:3)
- ◆ Thus our personal relationship with God comes by God's grace through faith in Jesus. (Ephesians 2:8-9)

God the Holy Spirit dwells within believers to grow their relationship with God. (2 Timothy 1:13-14)

- ◆ The Spirit grows believers through God's Word and the Lord's Supper. (Acts 2:42)
- ◆ The Spirit gathers believers into church families, granting each person gifts for building up the family of God. (I Corinthians 12:4-7)
- ◆ Evidence of the Spirit's work is seen in the lives of all followers of Christ. (Galatians 5:22-23)

God has promised that all who have faith in Jesus Christ will have a personal relationship with God through eternity. (2 Corinthians 5:1)

- ◆ Those who die trusting in Jesus are taken into heaven. (John 14:2-3)
- ◆ Jesus will return to judge the living and the dead. (Matthew 25:31-33)
- ◆ After the judgment, those who believe in Christ will spend eternity with God. (Romans 6:5, Revelation 21:1-4)
