Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I've got two major updates to share from Pastor Nathan's corner this month. First up, I will still be continuing to work on the new pictorial directory over the next few months as time permits, but it was pointed out to me that with the holiday season coming up and with people likely traveling for Thanksgiving and Christmas, it would be a challenging time to ask people to come in for the in-person photos at the church. With that in mind, I have updated the timeframe for launching the pictorial directory to February of next year. I plan on setting up times throughout that month for people to come to church to have their pictures taken if they desire. The hope would be to have the online directory up and running by the start of February for all of those who desire to upload their own photographs.

Trinity Coffee Connect! This project will consist of a handful of volunteers and myself making and serving free coffee and other beverages and snacks to visitors of Trinity House, to the Leavenworth High School students and parents who regularly come by the church, and to other members of the community. We'll be setting up a table with an espresso machine out in the church parking lot to be available to these people with the hopes of building relationships with them and hopefully finding opportunities for sharing the Gospel with them. We will also be providing water bottles and granola bars as well for those who might not be interested in coffee along with juice boxes for younger kids.

Our goal with this coffee table is to build relationships to better spread the Gospel in our community. The coffee and everything else are present only for the purpose of serving that goal. They are meant to be a means of sharing hospitality with people to encourage conversation and relationships with the people who are already coming by our church campus. If people are in an absolute hurry, we will serve them, but this project is meant to be a place for building community and conversation, not drive-through coffee. To help encourage this, we would like to have a prayer board and prayer cards available at the table where people can write down requests and share as much as they feel comfortable.

Keep an eye out for a sign-up sheet at the welcome center if this sounds like something you would like to help with! I am planning on always being present at this table whenever it is set up, so please don't feel intimidated about having to be the only person there to run everything and share the Gospel. Barring sickness or emergency, I plan to adjust my office hour time to always be present. The plan is to have Trinity Coffee Connect up and running during drop-off and pick-up hours for the high school and during Trinity House's hours of operation, but the frequency for having the table open will depend on the number and availability of volunteers to assist running it. So if this is something you'd love to get involved in, look for that sign-up sheet or reach out to me directly! I truly believe that this is a project that has the opportunity to become a meaningful way for our church to impact the people that God is already placing on our campus and that it has the potential to grow into something special in our community. I am excited to start sharing the love of Christ and some good coffee with people very soon!



- 20. Thank God for what He has provided for you. May all learn the secret of being content.


- **21.** Thank God for the people in your life. May we speak well of them and explain everything in the kindest way.
