Greetings Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Christmas of 2024 is now but a memory, but I wanted to give a word of thanks to all who worked to make the Advent/ Christmas season at Trinity a success. Many hours of work and preparation go into making this time of year special. Shoutout to our musicians, Trinity Choir, lay readers, Elders, those who prepared Advent meals and baked cookies, the team that decorated the sanctuary (and took it down!), the team that set up the outdoor nativity scene (and took it down!), volunteers who assisted in Operation Christmas Child, the organizers and donors for the Adopt a Bag for Trinity House, those that donated, prepared and served Christmas dinner for those in need, and of course Pastor Damain and Pastor Nathan for leading us in worship.

The Campus Coordinating Committee (CCC) is made up of Board Chairs, Officers and Called Staff and meets once a month. The focus of the January meeting was the annual training on a variety of topics that are summarized below. If you have any questions or need additional information in any of these areas, please reach out to one of the Officers or Pastors.

- **Administration** Trinity works hard on disseminating information to its members and being as transparent as possible. Each Board Chair/Officer has a mailbox in the Church office where items can be placed for pickup. Our website www.tlcleavenworth.org is a treasure trove of information. Under the Resources/Administration tab you will find our Constitution, By-Laws, Operations Manual and many other documents that outline the operations of our Church.
- Finances/Accounting There are specific forms in the Church Office used for requesting payment for or reimbursement of purchases made on behalf of the Church. Detailed monthly financial reports are emailed to the CCC and a Treasurer's Recap Report is published in the Trinity Times. Detailed reports can be requested from the Church office as well.
- **AED/First Aid** Dr. Lori Golon conducted training on our Automated External Defibrillator (AED) device and how to use Narcan. Both items, as well as a trauma kit, are located near the Welcome Center. We pray that there is never a need for these tools at our facility, but we are prepared if needed.
- **Sexual Misconduct Prevention Policy** Pastor Damian reviewed this policy, which can also be found on our website. In a nutshell, if you see something say something. Safeguards and precautions are in place to prevent sexual misconduct from happening, but our best defense is your eyes and awareness. Reports of any misconduct can be made to one of the Church officers or pastors. The President of the Congregation is designated as the sole spokesperson should the need arise.
- **Copyright Policy** Trinity is very diligent in making sure that we are in compliance with all copyright laws. Simply put, we do not want to steal from any musicians, songwriters, etc. We spend roughly \$2000 per year for licensing and have designated members who report and monitor for compliance.
- **Church Calendar** The Church Congregational Secretary keeps a master calendar of events that take place at Trinity. The calendar is sent out to the CCC monthly and helps to keep everyone informed and on track.

Present: Jeff Thorne, Pastor Nathan, Ron Romig, Jean Fluevog, Mark Denney, and Laura Gray.

President Mark Denney called the meeting to order and shared a Thanksgiving devotion. A motion was made and seconded (Fluevog/Thorne) to approve the minutes of the October meeting as printed. The motion passed 3-0.

OLD BUSINESS

Time and Talent Survey: Mr. Denney will work with Rod Low on the Time and Talent survey in the coming year. **Electronic Messaging Center**: Mr. Denney spoke with Ann at Young Sign Co. She is aware that we are still interested in pursuing the electronic messaging center.

Pictorial Directory: Pastor Nelson will be in touch with John Gray in January to begin the process for the pictorial directory

Security System: Mr. Stillian had a walk-through with a representative from Castle Guard Security. The representative revised the estimate recommending eight smoke detectors rather than the four originally bid. The new estimate is \$2815.00. The Board of Properties will take care of removing the lock from the northeast door and covering the hole. A motion was made and seconded (Fluevog/Thorne) to approve up to \$3000.00, rather than the \$2500.00 originally approved, for Castle Guard to update the security system and smoke detectors. The motion passed unanimously.

Trinity By-laws: Mr. Denney will send a copy of the By-Laws dated November 17, 2024 to the District.

BOD MEMBER UPDATES

Staff: Pastor Nathan reported the vacancy service at Our Savior in KC, KS went fine.

1st Vice President: Mr. Denney reported on the October financials. Expenses for the month of October exceeded receipts by \$16,940. Monthly expenses included \$10,500 for Approved Asphalt to reseal the parking lot. This could be taken from the building reserves. Total cash on hand at the end of October was \$605,631. Mr. Denney submitted the approved 2025 Work Program to Amy and the giving amount needed weekly to Sheri. In January he plans to update signatures on the church accounts.

NEW BUSINESS

Kansas District Convention: Pastor Nathan will be Trinity's pastoral delegate to the Kansas District Convention June 5
-6 in Salina. The congregation will also send a lay voting delegate. A motion was made and seconded (Fluevog/Thorne) to approve Pastor Nelson as the pastoral delegate and appoint Kathy Rush as Trinity's lay delegate for the 2025 District Convention. The motion passed unanimously.

CCC Training: Mr. Denney proposed conducting all the CCC training at the January CCC meeting rather than having one section at each meeting. The following assignments for training were approved: Mr. Denney – Administrative matters, Pastor Snyder – Sexual Misconduct Policy and Copyrights, Calendar – Mrs Gray. Other topics will be assigned later.
