# President's Letter

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

There is something about the “dog days of summer” that makes us slow down. The days are hot, the nights can be warm, and our usual routines may seem a little harder to maintain. Vacations, family gatherings, outdoor activities, and simply trying to stay cool can change the rhythm of our lives. Summer has a way of reminding us that every season has its own pace.

The church also experiences different seasons. There are times when ministry seems to be bursting with energy – like during our recent week of Vacation Bible School. Worship attendance is strong, Sunday School classrooms are full, fellowship events are well attended, and volunteers are eager to serve. At other times, things seem quieter. The “dog days” of summer can remind us that a slower season does not mean that God has stopped working.

In fact, some of the most important work God does in us happens during those quieter seasons. We are reminded that the church does not depend upon our energy, enthusiasm, or accomplishments. And just as the heat of summer eventually gives way to the cooler days of autumn, the seasons of the church also change. God continues to call His people to use their gifts in service to Him and to one another.
